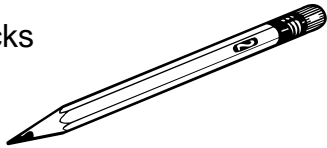


2009 - 2010 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

NOTE: The following are the basic supplies needed to start the school year. Please check with individual schools for additions/deletions. Some consumable supplies may need to be replenished during the course of the year.

KINDERGARTEN

1. Crayons (16 colors)
2. White glue (two 8 oz. bottles)
3. Four pencils (regular #2)
4. Facial tissues (250 count box)
5. White (preferred) or manila drawing paper, 12 X 18 (100 sheets)
6. Construction paper, assorted colors 12 X 18 (80 sheets)
7. Washable water color markers
8. Two folders with pockets
9. Watercolors with brush
10. Hand wipes (1 box)
11. Scissors - blunt
12. Two wide rule spiral tablets (70 sheets)
13. Large eraser
14. Two small glue sticks



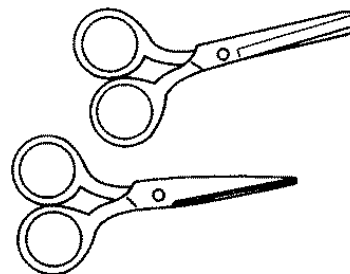
FIRST GRADE

1. Crayons (16 colors)
2. White glue 8 oz.
3. Four pencils (regular #2)
4. Facial tissues (250 count box)
5. Four Mead/McDougal-Littell tablets (Mead #48170, #48512, #48166, or #48156) or School Depot (#SD21006) (check with schools)
6. Scissors (sharp point)
7. White (preferred) or manila drawing paper, 12 X 18 (100 sheets)
8. Construction paper, assorted colors 12 X 18 (80 sheets)
9. Six folders with pockets only (no brads) and one folder with pockets and brads
10. School box (plastic) or plastic zipper bag
11. Watercolors with brush
12. Large eraser
13. Three wide rule spiral notebooks (40 sheets) non-perforated (primary rule - if available)
14. Hand wipes (1 box)
15. One red pencil
16. Washable water color markers



SECOND GRADE

1. Crayons (16 colors)
2. White glue 8 oz.
3. Four pencils (regular #2)
4. Facial tissues (250 count box)
5. Three Mead/McDougal-Littell tablets (Mead #48039, #48156, #48512, #48210, or #25334) or School Depot (#SD21006) (check with schools)
6. Scissors (sharp point)
7. Four folders with pockets and brads
8. School box (plastic, small size) or zipper bag
9. White (preferred) or manila drawing paper, 12 X 18 (100 sheets)
10. Construction paper, heavy weight, assorted colors 12 X 18 (80 sheets)
11. Watercolors with brush
12. Plastic ruler, 12" (inch and centimeter)
13. Two red marking pencils
14. Large eraser
15. Four wide rule spiral tablets (70 sheets)
16. Wide rule notebook paper (200 count)
17. Hand wipes (1 box)
18. One box map colors
19. One highlighter (yellow)
20. Washable water color markers



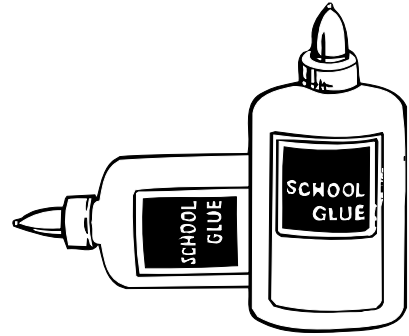

6. Two packages notebook paper (wide rule, loose leaf) 200 ct.
7. Three spiral notebooks (wide rule)
8. Scissors (sharp point)
9. Eight solid color folders with brads and pockets (assorted colors)
10. Plastic ruler, 12" (inch and centimeter)
11. White (preferred) or manila drawing paper 12 X 18 (50 sheets)
12. Construction paper, assorted colors 12 X 18 (40 sheets)
13. Watercolors with brush
14. Colored pencils
15. Heavy duty zipper pouch (large) or large school box
16. Two red marking pencils
17. One highlighter (yellow)
